PACE PROGRAM: CANDIDATE FOR MEMBERSHIP CLASS “A” PATHWAYS

Candidate must meet criteria for membership, complete online National Orientation and criminal check BEFORE Playing Ability Test. After Candidate Passes the PAT, they have a minimum of 3 years, maximum of 6 years to complete the following:

ALL Candidates are required to work within the “golf Industry” until Class “A” status is obtained

Candidates for Membership may choose ONE of the following career pathways, but may change mid-stream:
